

Together signs Memorandum of Understanding for cooperation with Premier Dead Sea – a leading Israeli producer, developing and manufacturing cosmetic products based on Dead Sea minerals.

Under the terms of the binding memorandum of principles, the companies will work together to develop, manufacture and market a line of care products combining Dead Sea minerals with CBD – a natural cannabis compound produced from the cannabis plant to which science attributes a range of essential therapeutic effects

Together plans supplying cannabis plants and their derivatives from Israel and other farms outside of Israel

Ashkelon, May 10 - 2018 Together (TASE: TGDR) has announced that Globus Pharma, its operations company specializing in growing and producing medical cannabis, has signed a binding memorandum of principles for cooperation with Premier Dead Sea, an Israeli company with global operations in the field of cosmetics products based on Dead Sea minerals. According to the agreement, the companies will work together to develop, manufacture and market a line of cosmetics care products, combining Dead Sea minerals with CBD (cannabidiol) – a natural cannabinoid compound produced by extracting the medical cannabis inflorescence.

The end product will be distributed and marketed to countries in which CBD compounds have been legalized and does not require a doctor's prescription including many countries in Europe as well as Canada. Under the terms of the binding memorandum of principles, the parties will contract through a detailed binding agreement within 60 days, subject to contingent conditions.

Together intends building a factory to manufacture and process the joint products according to required standards. The company expects that construction of the factory will begin during the third quarter of 2018, and that launching of planned operations will be during the first quarter of 2019.

As far as is known to the company, the CBD market is currently worth hundreds of millions of dollars annually. According to "Forbes," the market is expected to grow 700% by 2020, and according to data provided by market research company "Hemp Business Journal," it will reach about \$2.1 billion by 2020.

Together CEO Nissim Bracha: "We are delighted with the cooperation agreement with Premier, which aims to manufacture and market products combining the therapeutic qualities of Dead Sea minerals with those of CBD compounds. Since CBD based cosmetic products are already being marketed worldwide, we see cooperation with a leading player in care products based on Dead Sea minerals with experience, knowhow and a global network, as an additional potential for revenue for the company."

"A range of beneficial characteristics for various illnesses is attributed to CBD by science due to its anti-inflammatory, anti-bacterial, antioxidant and anti-aging properties. Cosmetic products based on CBD do not include the THC component, which is the part of cannabis that has a psychoactive effect and this makes it attractive to combine CBD with these products."

"In addition to agreements signed in Canada and Germany for tens of tons of medical cannabis as well as agreements we are promoting for marketing medical cannabis and its products, from the farms that we are setting up in Israel and abroad, it is also our intention to strive towards obtaining a foothold in the cosmetics based on cannabis plant properties market. We believe that this step will contribute to growth of the company's revenue and provide value for our shareholders."
